Dear Friends of Saint Charles Caritas:

I hope you had a wonderful 4th of July weekend!

On behalf of Saint Charles Caritas we want to welcome with gusto Fr. Nemesio Sungcad, Priest Administrator of the St. Charles Parish.

The Holy Rosaries have been mailed for the "Wounded Warriors" at the Air Force Base, Ramstein Hospital in Germany. It will take about 2 to 3 weeks before our contact will receive the box. These will go first to the U.S. Embassy in Jerusalem then Germany. We thank the Ross brother and sister who were instrumental in the process of bringing the rosaries to the wounded warriors.

Caritas schedule:

- **Every 3rd Sunday of the month including Saturdays are the Caritas Days.** All day Sunday & 5pm Saturday. The following Thursday is the Costco buy of food for our 6 charities in Tijuana.
- **July 10 at 8am meeting place outside the office of the church for the transport of bedding sets from a 5 star hotel.** We need vans to go with us and transport the hotel's donation. The area is in the hotel circle of San Diego. These will all go to the 6 charities in Tijuana that we are helping.
- **August 7, Saturday from 8am is the "Visit to the Casa de Cuna orphanaged/disadvantage children" ages from 3 months old to 6 years old.** We are going to serve lunches to the children. We will be back by 3pm. If you are interested to join us, please send me an email or call me.
- **October 9, Saturday from 8am is our "Visit to the Adoratrices del Santisimo".** We will see the church that these contemplative nuns are building. The church may not be finished this year. The Saint Charles Caritas is helping the nuns buy the ingredients for the pastries that they are baking/selling for their fund raising to build the church. It has been more than 15 years since they started building this church.
