

Dear Friends of Saint Charles Caritas, *Charity on the Border*:

**Thank you so much for your kindness to the poor small children.**

Our next Caritas Day will be on **June 15 & 16, Saturday & Sunday** 100% of your donations will be used to buy basic food & some cleaning supplies. Please see the nuns at the exit doors on Sunday & volunteers on the two 5pm masses. **June 22, Saturday** at 10:30 am is the Costco buy of food for 5 charities.

**Project Milk:** The Saint Charles Caritas goal is to provide **22 cans** of 3.52 lbs Nestle Nido powdered milk to 3 charity institutions every month. The milk will go to the small children for their 2 weeks consumption. The recipients of these monthly Project Milk are: Casa de Cuna, home for small children, Santa Teresita, home for small girls & Madre Rita, home for single mothers with children. For 2 weeks, Casa de Cuna consume 12 cans, Santa Tersita, 6 and Madre Rita, 4. The average budget for 22 cans of powdered milk is \$330/per month.

If you want to donate, the stores that have cheaper prices are: Wal-Mart, Food for Less and Northgate. The prices range from \$13.98 to \$14.99 per can of 3.52 lbs (53 servings/can). You may drop off at St. Charles office your donations or leave a message at my phone, or send me an email. And please tell the ladies at the church office that they are for Caritas. Also you can drop off the milk during Caritas Day. Please see below sample of the canned powdered milk.



We are praying and hoping that at least we can help these children for their 2 weeks consumption of milk which they need so much for their growth and health.
