The Saint Charles Caritas Day will be this coming weekend, **July 20 & 21 (Sat. & Sun)**. 100% of your donations will be used to buy basic food and some cleaning supplies for the 7 charities that you are helping, 2 in San Diego & 5 in TJ. All the TJ charity institutions are run by nuns. Please see them outside the exit doors on Sunday and volunteers at the two 5pm masses.

Project Milk #3: Nestle Nido Powdered Milk 3.52 lbs a can. The threshold of Caritas is 22 cans. These are the consumption of 3 charity institutions with small children for 2 weeks. We would like to ask you if you can donate the milk. You can buy it at Wal-Mart, Food for Less and Northgate stores and drop them off at Caritas Day or drop them at the church office and let the ladies know that they are for the Caritas. I will pick them up on Saturday morning.

On **July 27, Saturday** is the Costco buy of food for the 5 charities. We need volunteers.

We are going to visit 2 more charity institutions next **Sept. & Nov. 2013**. We are going to visit the Asilo Juan Pablo, home for the elderly and the Madre Rita, home for destitute single mothers. The date will be announced. More likely, it will fall on the second Saturday of the month. If you would like to volunteer, please send me an email. We are going to serve the same food that we served for our visits to the other charities in TJ.

I hope to see you on Caritas Day or one of the events.
