I would like to let you know that we are suspending the used clothes again because the nuns have a hard time crossing used clothes to TJ borders. However, we continue to need toiletries and canned foods.

The rebate from Costco Executive Card/Amex Card of \$750 will be used to budget the lunches/breakfast of the nuns and helpers (2 lunches and a breakfast per month). The budget is \$100 per month. These amounts will last about 7 months.
