We have zero overhead costs and no administrative layers. We are helping the children development center, home for girls, home for the elderly, contemplative nuns, homes for boys and girls, 2 different location of child development centers, poor children in barangay 26 zones 1 to 6, 2 different locations for children catechism, oratorio children and teach the children how to pray the rosary. **Right after the 1 pm mass, we will buy food for the charity congregations for Tijuana/Ensenada.** Thank you for your generosity and may God showers you with His peace and good health.

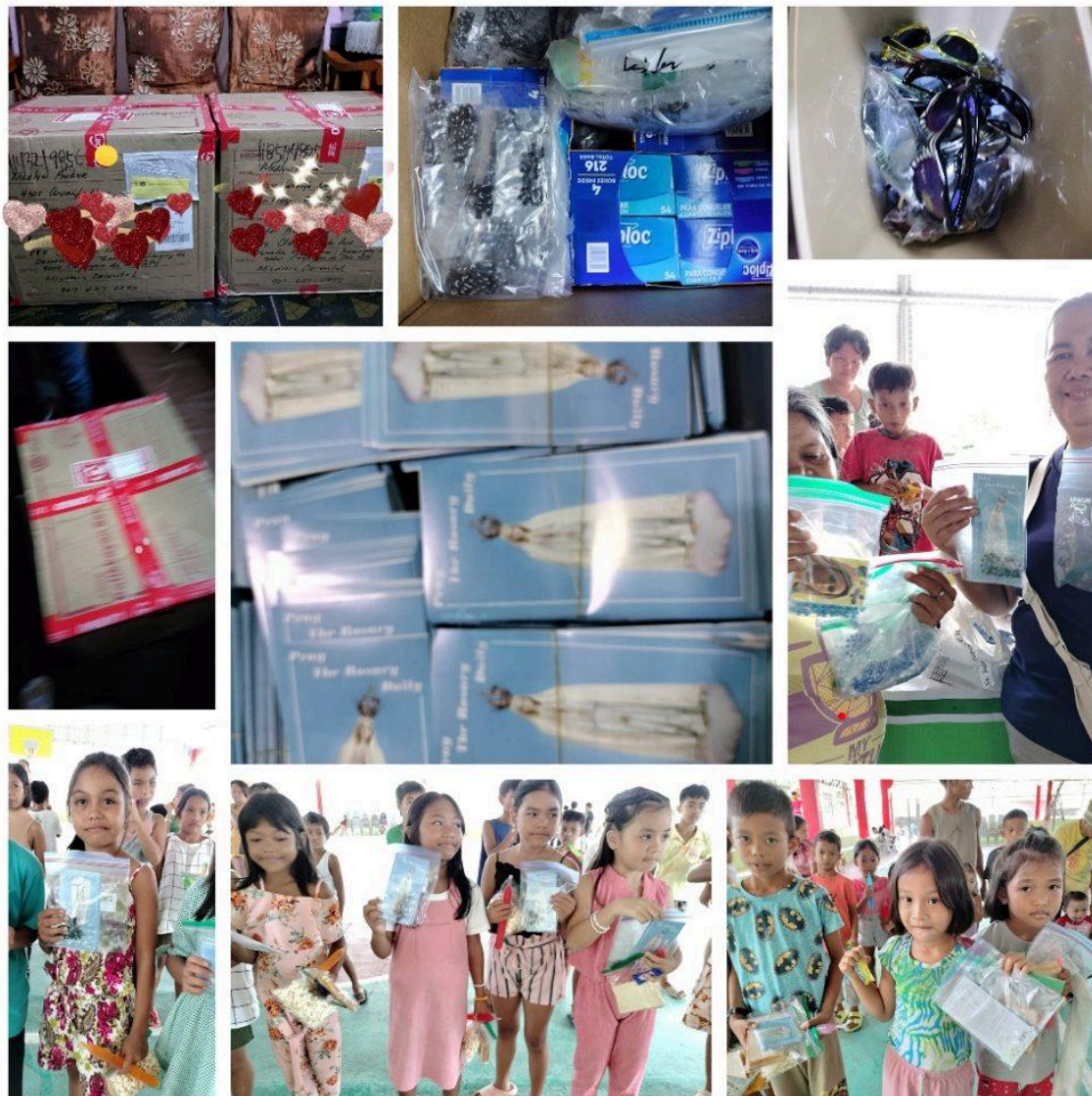
