Caritas schedule: This month of August, the Caritas will not fall under the 3rd Sunday week of the month (in which we commonly have) due to the mission appeal of the School Sisters of Notre Dame. Because of this, we understand and decided to have the Caritas Day on the 4th Sunday (with Saturday) for this month. Please support the Sisters. Thank you.

August 24 & 25 (Saturday & Sunday) will be the Caritas Day. 100% of your donations will be used to buy basic food and basic necessities for the charities that we are helping. We are all volunteers, zero overhead costs and no administrative layers. Please see the core of volunteers on Saturday and nuns on Sunday masses at the exit doors. We are helping the children development center, home for girls, home for the elderly, contemplative sisters, child development center, children from the upper Carmen, zones 1 to 6, Daughters of Charity Stella Maris catechism, oratorio children, home for girls and home for boys and teach the children how to pray the rosary in the squatter area. After Sunday 1 pm mass, we are going to buy food/cleaning supplies for the charity congregations from Tijuana/Ensenada. Thank you for your generosity and may God shower you with peace, blessings and abundant graces.

Projects:

- School supplies for Tijuana/Ensenada children: Casa de Cuna, 38 Children Development Center (formerly an orphanage) and 50 children in Santa Teresita, home for girls.
- Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary Blue t-shirts for 67 children and 3 volunteers. In September is the children's 5th anniversary. Currently, the children have been wearing brown t-shirt for 5 years. The brown t-shirts are faded and worn out. The t-shirt cost was 2.07 pesos each x 70 = \$144.90 (5 years ago).

- Anonymous couple earmarked donation for the slippers for upper Carmen poor children; and food (fried chicken with rice and drinks for December in zones 1 to 6 children. There will be no Caritas Day in December)

- Knights of Columbus donated 172 plastic envelopes/face masks/bags for the children in Cagayan de Oro island.

**** 393 children were the recipients of the school supplies**. There was \$1,500 donated by an anonymous donor (\$1500/393 children = \$3.81 school supplies cost per kid).

**The 9 boxes of food, hygiene products and sports items were finally received this July. These boxes were sent on April 3 and May 10. Apparently, the shipment delay was in China port. The boxes went to Taiwan port on May 10, were processed on time based on the courier schedule.

Collage 1, pictures 1 across, the two teachers from the Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary in Paliparan, Cavite, received 1 box of food for the children and some food gifts for the three volunteers who also reside in the

squatter area. The teachers were the recipients of the Dream Foundation run by the religious. Teacher Analiza and teacher Regine graduated their 4 year degree courses. Both were scholars by the said foundation. *Pictures 2 across,* the 2 different preschoolers and zones 1 - 6 children received 2 boxes for their snacks, and hygiene products for Calabrian Children Foundation, home for girls and home for boys, and Daughters of Charity Stella Maris catechism formation.


