I'm thanking God for you daily that He may grant you His peace, good health, graces and blessings to all of you. Also, thank you to the children in this charity who continuously praying for us. I THANKED GOD FOR ALL OF YOU!!!

Short narrative: This March 2025, the Saint Charles Caritas is now 24 years of service to charities in Mexico (24 years), in the Philippines (6 years) and in the USA (24 years). James Paul (aka Jim) and Merlyn Baker founded this charity in 2001 with the blessing of Father Dennis Mikulanis. The Bakers were glad that Father Dennis loves the poor. At that time, the Bakers did not think about running a charity since both of them had full-time jobs and on call for for their management jobs. But God prevails on this. The time management came in for both, with God's grace.

Before 2001, looking back on their experienced, realizing that they were trained to be ready to run a charity. Before this charity, the Bakers had been volunteering at St. Vincent de Paul under Fr Father Joe Carroll. The Bakers were also catechists, teaching the students' confirmation, and also were Extra Ordinary Ministers under Father Fernando Ramirez. Jim was assigned to jail ministry while Merlyn's ministry of the sick, and she had been involved with other non-profit professional organizations.

The charity has now expanded from 1 charity in Tijuana to 4 plus charities today, (and was 9 charities before, but the religious communities had closed). The Philippines charities started during 2019 pandemic time through Sister Babylyn Dulfo SA, Franciscan Sisters of the Atonement, and now 9 charities that we are helping in Cagayan de Oro and 1 in Paliparan, Cavite today. The Bakers also included the Pastoral Charity Fund of St. Charles Church to help in the community who is in dire need of help. This started during Father Fernando Ramirez, pastor at that time, and to this day, this ministry continued. The Homeless Help in the South Bay started in November 2013, later named after Jim since he started the charity. Jim passed away December 25, 2013, but continued the distribution of food until pandemic time had arrived, and few months later after the pandemic, this program was halted. The rest of the narrative about Saint Charles Caritas are sent via emails and WhatsApp on a weekly and monthly basis in the form of a newsletter. Everyday this charity is a work in progress. God, thank you!

Caritas schedule in March:

• March 15 & 16, Saturday and Sunday are the Caritas Days. We are all volunteers from Mexico, Philippines and U.S. 100% of your donations will be used to buy basic food, cleaning supplies, basic necessities and projects. Please see the nuns on Sunday and core of volunteers on Saturday. We have zero overhead costs and no administrative layers. We are helping charities such as the Children Development Center (formerly an orphanage), Home for Girls, Home for the Elderly, Teach the Children How to Pray, 2 Child Development Centers, Children in Barangay 26 zones 1 to 6, Students Transportation Allowance Program, Catechism in Barangay Consolacion 7, Calabrian Children's Foundation (home for boys and home for girls), Canossian Children Oratorio, and little Gabriela (long distance adopted). Thank you for your generosity and may God bless you with His abundant graces and good health.


"March 2, 2025, Sunday
